



Ó 2023 i leith, tá an banna 'tradtronica' Huartan, atá lonnaithe i mBéal Feirste, ag cur beatha nua isteach i seanfhocail agus amhráin. Tá triúr cheoltóirí tráidisiúnta páirteach san ensemble bríomhar seo: Catriona Ní Ghribín, Múlú, and Stiofán Ó Luachrain, a fheidhmíonn mar léiritheoir an bhanna chomh maith. Is í an comhfhís atá acu ná traídisiúin amhránaíochta béil, cultúir agus teanga dhúchais Uladh a chur os comhair an lucht éisteachta comhaimseartha arís. Tá taispeántas beo Huartan mealltach agus osnádúrtha, le feisteas agus damhsóirí atá lán fuinnimh agus atá ina shamhail de shíogaí/ ilchruthaigh a bheith i láthair. In ath-shamhlú spraíul agus léiritheach ar Éirinn phágánach, cuireann gach príomhbhean Huartan gné de dhéacht 'un tosaigh – solas agus dorchadas, saol agus bás – agus an gaol teannasach eatarthu.

Since 2023, Belfast's 'tradtronica' band Huartan revitalizes ancient words and melodies. Comprising three Irish traditional musicians: Catriona Ní Ghribín, Múlú, and Stiofán Ó Luachrain, also the producer. They aim to reintroduce Ulster's oral singing traditions, cultures, and language. Huartan's live act is sensual, featuring costumes and high-energy backing dancers embodying síogaí presence. They playfully reimagine pagan Ireland, with front women channeling duality – light and dark, life and death.

Bíonn Tadhg ag scríobh gearrfhicsin agus filíochta chomh maith nuair a bhuaileann an splanc inspioráide doibhíú.

Amir Abu Alrob

Taibheoir & File ón Phalaistín / Palestinian poet & performer.
Is amharclannóir agus teifeach ón Phalaistín é Amir. Chuaigh siad sa 'Freedom Theatre' (TFT), campa dídeanaithe Jenin sa Phalaistín agus chaith sé 4 bliana ag staidéar Frithbheartaíocht Chultúrtha agus Amharclannaíochta. D'oibrigh siad mar éascaitheoir agus taibheoir le scoil TFT ón bhliain 2017 go dtí 2019. Bhí siad páirteach i ngluaiseacht LGBT sa Phalaistín.

Rev Ilewyn Máire (they/ she/ ki)

Is a queer animist culture worker who has been fermenting food, word, and sound in the Burren since 2015. Ki makes work as a community-based chef, facilitator, audiovisual artist, neuroqueer poet, and a ferment celebrant/ co-founder of Savage Craic. Ilewyn is devoted to sharing relationship driven, land-centred experiences that call for a return to the commons — art, music, poetry, and food that explores unique elements of exchange which centre decolonial community lifeways rooted in reciprocity and mutual liberation.

This has manifested through making space and creative work, organising events, pop-ups, and care offerings; performing live art and music in Europe, the UK and across Turtle Island since the early 90s.

Ilewyn is currently based in the Republic of Ireland.

Emily Waszak

Tá sé mar aidhm ag saothar Emily samhlaíocht frithchaipitlóch a chruthú mar chineál frithsheasmhachta in aghaidh thréigean eagraithe an stáit agus an chaipitil. Baineann sí úsaid as teicstíl mar mheán chun saothair atáirgthe baininscneach a fháil ar ais agus a athluacháil. Tá cleachtas Emily ábharach agus ag idirghníomhú le dramhaíl, bunábhair nádúrtha agus aimsithe agus a bhailítear ó shuíomhanna tionsclaíocha, ó thréigean agus ón tírdhreach nádúrtha, ag fíodóireacht tairseacha isteach sa rud nach bhfuil le feiceáil.

Emily is a visual artist based in Donegal. Emily's work is concerned with building anticapitalist imaginaries as prefigurative resistance to the organised abandonment of the state and capital. She uses textiles as a medium through which to reclaim and revalue feminised, reproductive labour

Emily's practice is material and embodied, interacting with waste, found and natural materials collected from sites of industry, abandonment and the natural landscape, weaving thresholds into the unseen

Lucy Ní hAodhagáin

Is curamóir spáis choibhneasta í Lucy a dhéanann iniúchadh agus freastal ar an dénártha braite idir daoine agus an dúlra. Bhunaigh Lucy eagraíocht darbh ainm ‘Wild Awake’ sa bhliain 2015 chun bealaí saoil sinseartha a athmhúscailt le haghaidh athghiniúna éiceolaíochta agus cultúrtha.


